

ORDER LIFTING OUTDOOR BURNING BAN

AN ORDER IMPLEMENTING EMERGENCY RULES DIRECTED AT THE PREVENTION OF WILDFIRES IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF MONTAGUE COUNTY, TEXAS HAS BEEN LIFTED.

WHEREAS, Montague County Judge has made a determination that there is no longer a need for a ban of outdoor burning in accordance with Section 352.081 of the Texas Government Code, and that said ban has this day been lifted.

WHEREAS, the threat of wildfires is greatly reduced, with the recent rains and milder weather but caution still needs to be used with any outdoor burning.
