The doors will be open and the hours are 8:00 till 12:00 and 1:00 till 4:45.

**The Office will be limited to 4 occupants at a time in the Records Room. (if more than 4 are present, occupants will be limited to 1 hour of research time, each occupant must sign in and document time of arrival)

**The Office will be limited to 2 occupants at a time at the Front Counter of the Main Office. (Please remain in the hall until Counter occupants exit if needed)

**Application for Marriage License must be made by <u>appointments only</u>. Forms are available on our website, <u>www.co.montague.tx.us</u> County Clerk, Forms. Fill this form out completely bring with you, both applicants must appear in person to issue.

******Those needing to record Assumed Names, Brands, etc. these forms are available on the website and can be filled out ahead of time to provide in and out quickly.

****Birth/Death Certificates: applications are also available online and can be filled out ahead of time to provide in and out quickly.**

**All other Document Recordings will be handled following such guidelines listed.

Any other questions feel free to give us a call. Our goal is to try and make this uncertain time as safe for the Employees and Staff as possible. I ask if you are sneezing, coughing, or have fever to <u>stay home and call</u>, we will do everything we can to accommodate you from there.
